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ORDER

A mid-discovery conference was held on February 17, 2011 with counsel for all parties and with defendant pro se Nancy McGinn. It appears for a number of reasons, discovery in the case has been delayed. The reasons include the litigation of numerous other issues, the number of attorneys and parties in the case, and the number of witnesses expected to be deposed. Given these factors, the present deadline for completion of discovery of July 1, 2011 appears unreasonable and that good cause appears to extend the deadline. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Uniform Pretrial Scheduling Order filed September 7, 2011 (Dkt. No. 136) is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. The deadline for completion of discovery is hereby extended to **December 1, 2011**;
- 2. The deadline for filing dispositive motions is hereby extended to **February 15, 2012**;
- 3. The "Trial Ready" date is hereby extended to March 15, 2012; and
- 4. The Uniform Pretrial Scheduling Order, as amended, remains in full force and effect in all other respects; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a further status conference will be held on **September**6, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the chambers of the undersigned to review the status of discovery in the case.¹
