PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

This Reply Memorandum of Law is filed to address the issues raised in the SEC's response dated November 12, 2013, in regards to the underlying Motion for living expenses and counsel fees filed on October 18, 2013. Since the filing of the underlying motion, James D. Linnan Esq., of Linnan & Fallon LLP, has been substituted as counsel to the Smith Trust, Geoffrey Smith and Lauren Smith. As such, this Reply is submitted solely on behalf of Lynn A. Smith.

First and foremost, what is indisputable is that Lynn Smith is a 67 year old woman who has a total monthly income of \$915 composed of \$727 in Social Security and an additional \$138 from the New York State Teacher Retirement Benefit. This income is supplemented by food stamps in the amount of \$50 per month. She has been slandered by the press and has done nothing wrong. Of all the victims of this tragic case Lynn Smith may be the greatest.

Although all of Lynn Smith's assets have been frozen she is still entitled to her day in court in the form of a trial by jury. On April 20, 2010 the SEC demanded a trial by jury on the face of the original Complaint. Each time the Complaint was amended the demand for a trial by jury remained. Now, at this late hour, the SEC haphazardly suggests that David Smith should concede that he is collaterally estopped from contesting liability so that this case can then proceed to a non-jury hearing on other critical facts. The SEC essentially has invited the defense to simply give up. We respectfully decline the invitation

It is the intent of Lynn Smith to have her day in court before a jury of her peers as soon as possible so that she can begin to pick up the shattered pieces of her former life and move on. Neither Lynn Smith, nor any other member of the Smith family, will allow the SEC to starve them into submission by holding their assets hostage.

Since March of 2013, the criminal trial transcript has been available to the SEC. In the April, 2013 settlement conference, which all parties attended in the Court's chambers, the SEC stated that they would file a motion for summary judgment. Seven motions later, there has been no such motion. The SEC has attributed the delay in seeking summary judgment to the high cost of obtaining the criminal trial transcript. The defendants believe that the SEC has delayed because they know that it will not resolve any of the major issues in this case. The defendant urges all parties to move forward expediously, to trial.

Lynn Smith further urges the Court to grant her request for living expenses and attorney fees so that she can finance a defense on the merits. In short, enough is enough. This case should be adjudicated as soon as administratively possible.

ARGUMENT

POINT I

PRELIMINARY DECISIONS AND ORDERS ARE NOT DISPOSITIVE BASED ON THE LAW OF THE CASE DOCTRINE AND A TRIAL IS NECESSARY TO DETERMINE LIABILITY AND OWNERSHIP OF THE SMITH ASSETS.

Preliminary rulings as to the likely outcome on the merits for preliminary injunction orders do not establish law of the case. (Dkt. No. 610-12 at 10). The Supreme Court of the United States of America has recognized this and held that "[a] party ... is not required to prove his case in full at a preliminary-injunction hearing...and the findings of fact and conclusions of law made by a court granting a preliminary injunction are not binding at a trial on the merits." <u>University of Texas v. Camenisch</u>, 451 U.S. 390, 395 (1981).

Similarly, the Second Circuit has stated that "the decision of both the trial and appellate court on whether to grant or deny a temporary injunction does not preclude the parties in any way from litigating the merits of the case." <u>DiLaura v. Power Autho.</u>, 982 F.2d 73, 77 (quoting 11 Charles A. Wright & Arthur R. Miller, Federal Practice & Procedure § 2962, at 630–31 (1973)). New York State decisional law also recognizes this proposition and has held that the "[Grant] or denial of a motion for a preliminary injunction does not constitute the law of the case or an adjudication on the merits...therefore, the issues must be tried as if no application for a preliminary injunction had been made." <u>Ratner v. Fountains Clove Road Apartments, Inc.</u>, 118 A.D.2d 843, 843 (2d Dept.1986); <u>Fortunoff v. Triad Land Associates</u>, 906 F. Supp. 107, 113 (E.D.N.Y. 1995).

In the instant matter the SEC erroneously states that Lynn Smith has:

"...ignor[ed] the three-day evidentiary hearing in June 2010 establishing that David Smith for many years used the stock account as a financing tool for the broker-dealer, and the evidentiary hearing and voluminous submissions during the second half of 2010 proving the lies of Lynn Smith and those around her regarding the Smiths' control of the Trust."

(Dkt. No. 630 at 6).

However, in reality it is the SEC themselves, who have chosen to "ignore" the fundamental principal that no litigant is required to prove their case on the merits at a hearing for a provisional remedy. Senior District Court Judge Sharpe, has, in the instant matter, recognized that preliminary injunction determinations do not establish law of the case. In Judge Sharpe's May 6, 2011 Memorandum Decision and Order, which granted the SEC's request to amend the complaint, he held that:

Judge Homer's findings were not boundless; to the contrary, they were based on proof extracted from a condensed discovery, governed by the "substantial showing of likelihood of success" standard, and confined to evaluating the assets' susceptibility to freezing. Thus, in light of these limitations, and because the pending motions implicate the adequacy of the SEC's pleadings regarding distinct issues, reliance on the law of the case doctrine here would seem to offend the well-settled principle that the doctrine be "only addressed to its good sense." Higgins v. Cal. Prune & Apricot Grower, Inc., 3 F.2d 896, 898 (2d. Cir. 1924) (citations omitted); see also <u>City of Anaheim v.</u> Duncan, 658 F.2d 1326, 1328 n.2 (9th Cir. 1981) ("[A] decision on a preliminary injunction does not constitute the law of the case" (citation omitted)); Berrigan v. Sigler, 499 F.2d 514, 518 (D.C. Cir. 1974) ("The decision of a ...court whether to grant or deny a preliminary injunction does not constitute the law of the case for the purposes of further proceedings" (citations omitted)); Garten v. Hochman, No. 08 Civ. 9425, 2010 WL 2465479, at *3 n.1 (S.D.N.Y. June 16, 2010) ("[T]he law of the case doctrine is not typically applied in connection with preliminary

determinations, such as a ruling on a motion for a preliminary injunction." (citation omitted)); see, e.g., <u>Davidson v. Bartholome</u>, 460 F. Supp. 2d 436, 443 (S.D.N.Y. 2006) (finding the law of the case doctrine inapplicable where the court ruled on a summary judgment motion "before any meaning discovery," and was later presented with a summary judgment motion after discovery had been completed.

Dkt. No. 321 at 20-22.

The longstanding case law and the ruling in the instant matter by Judge Sharpe conclusively demonstrate that the SEC's reliance on the preliminary rulings is erroneous. The SEC's statement that "the stock account and the Trust account are both likely to be found as assets of David Smith..." is nothing more than a hopeful fantasy, and more importantly, it is clearly not the law of the case. The SEC's belief is founded upon the Court's perspective of the "likelihood of success" as to the ownership of the stock account and trust account in the context of the truncated evidentiary hearing on the asset freeze. At trial a jury could, and we believe likely will, easily determine that the stock account is an individual asset owned by Lynn Smith and that the trust account was created in good faith. It is completely baseless for the SEC to think these issues have already been decided, when they are clear issues of fact.

POINT II

EVEN IF A COLLATERAL ESTOPPEL THEORY IS SUCCESSFULLY ASSERTED, SUMMARY JUDGMENT WILL BE LIMITED TO THE CRIMINAL JUDGMENT RESTITUTION AMOUNT AND THE ISSUE OF OWNERSHIP OF THE SMITH ASSETS WILL STILL NEED TO BE LITIGATED.

The SEC has alleged in the Second Amended Complaint that Lynn Smith has violated New York State's Debtor and Creditor Law. To the best of counsel's knowledge, there has been no evidence to support this assertion. The SEC's so-called "substantial likelihood of success" does not offer any proof that Lynn Smith has violated any law and certainly does not prove that the stock account is a joint asset.

The SEC suggests that the defendants should concede liability because of collateral estoppel. Even assuming, *arguendo*, that collateral estoppel can be used to gain a judgment against David Smith, the criminal judgment Order makes clear that David Smith's restitution amount is equal to \$5,989,736. (Exhibit "A"). This number is further reduced by the criminal presentencing investigation report that determines that \$241,014 of the total restitution amount is composed of tax losses. Therefore, the SEC would at most be entitled to a summary judgment of \$5,748,722 against David Smith. Such a ruling would prove nothing against Lynn Smith in either her role as a relief defendant or as a defendant in the fraudulent conveyance action. It will not decide the issues of ownership of the stock account and trust account but it would certainly limit and identify what funds if any, could be subject to the relief defendant claims.

POINT III

LYNN SMITH'S MOTION FOR LIVING EXPENSES SHOULD BE GRANTED.

Not surprisingly, the SEC has shown no sympathy or concern for the desperate situation that Lynn Smith has spiraled into. Instead, the SEC continues to oppose Lynn Smith's request for living expenses. This, in spite of their earlier statement from their opposition papers dated October 8, 2010:

"...the Commission would not be opposed to a modest carve-out for essential living expenses...Mrs. Smith should explain in a sworn accounting how she spent funds [from the sale of the camp] before she is allowed access to frozen funds."

Dkt. No.151 at 7.

Counsel for Lynn Smith urges the Court to display compassion and be cognizant of the fact Lynn Smith is an individual who is 67 years old, has no available financial resources and no close by family to care for her. She too is a victim of the wrongdoing of which her husband has been convicted.

The SEC has submitted that Lynn Smith's motion for living expenses should be denied because Lynn Smith (1) fails to account for \$275,000 from the sale of the Sacandaga Lake house, (2) fails to provide any account statements from her checking account, (3) fails to disclose that her beloved primary residence is a significant asset, and (4) does not explain why she needs \$448 in gas per month. In response to the SEC's statements, Lynn Smith submits additional bank statements to the Court that account for all the proceeds, and further addresses each of the other SEC's contentions.

In July of 2010, shortly after Lynn Smith received the proceeds from the sale of the house on Sacandaga Lake, David Smith opened up a bank account in Lynn Smith's name at Adirondack Trust. Just like any other asset of the Smith family, the Adirondack Trust account was managed by David Smith. All of the proceeds from the sale of the Sacandaga property were deposited and debited through the Adirondack Trust account. However, on information and belief the account was kept with a low account balance due to the fear that it would be frozen by the government. As a result, on July 27, 2010 a treasurer's check was drawn in the amount of \$275,000 so that the Smiths could maintain

control of these funds going forward. As time progressed, the treasurer's check would be drawn upon and small deposits would be made into the account to meet necessary expenses. On August 3, 2011 the Smiths deposited the last remaining proceeds from the \$275,000 treasurer's check which amounted to \$40,000. The Adirondack Trust bank statements from July, 2010 through April, 2012 are attached hereto as Exhibit "B". The bank statements reveal that the account has maintained a balance of less than \$20.00 since September of 2011 and that all of the proceeds from the sale of the camp are gone.

Since April, 2010, when the Smiths' assets were frozen, David Smith had maintained a checking account at First National Bank of Scotia to pay household expenses. The deposits into the account were mainly from social security benefits and other legitimate income sources such as the rental of the Saratoga residence during the track season. As these records demonstrate, Lynn Smith's "average monthly debits" have been \$7,265 over the past six months. (Exhibit "C"). However, all of these expenses were incurred before David Smith was incarcerated. Since Lynn Smith now lives alone and has extremely limited income, her "average monthly debits" will of course decrease.

The SEC has suggested that "Lynn Smith has chosen not to free up the significant equity in her home." This disingenuous statement fails to recognize the dramatic change in Lynn Smith's lifestyle and that she views her longstanding home as the only thing she has left. The Saratoga Springs home provides Lynn Smith with a place of comfort and refuge during a very challenging time period in her life. The insincere recommendation by the SEC of simply "freeing up the equity" is much easier said than done for Lynn Smith because she has no other available living accommodations at this time, nor any prospects of gaining alternative living accommodations. Indeed, the SEC has not even

indicated that they would not seek to freeze her portion of the assets. The SEC's statements suggest that their own counsel is bitter with the fact that they were unsuccessful in the attempt to allow the Receiver to sell the Saratoga residence. Due to Lynn Smith's limited monthly income, it would be very difficult for her to pay for an apartment or purchase a smaller home. However, if the Court was to grant Lynn Smith a modest amount of money for living expenses, it may allow her to pursue other living accommodations which could then provide her with access to the equity in her residence.

Finally, the SEC's spiteful attempt to deprive Lynn Smith of any meaningful lifestyle, has lead to even challenging monthly gas expenses. Understanding, as we do, that counsel for the SEC undoubtedly travel by subway pass we would urge that the Court acknowledge that life in the capital district generally requires motor vehicle transportation. The \$448 monthly gas expense is reasonable due to the significant amount of driving Lynn Smith is forced to do each month. For example, when Lynn Smith wants to visit her husband she must travel to Brooklyn. Upon information and belief, David Smith will eventually be moved to the Otisville Federal Correction Institute. Lynn Smith plans to visit David Smith as frequently as possible, and a round trip to the prison is approximately 300 miles. Additionally, a round trip to the property located on Sacandaga Lake is also 60 miles. These are just two small examples that demonstrate that Lynn Smith does a significant amount of driving and her monthly gas expenses should not be second guessed.

Lynn Smith, the Smith Trust and children request that a portion of the frozen assets should be released so that counsel can be begin preparing for the jury trial that will ensue. It would be offensive to the principals of due process if Lynn Smith was forced to

go to trial with no way to pay the costs associated with expert testimony, preparation of evidence, and a reasonable payment to counsel simply because the opposing litigant was an arm of the United States government. Although previous motions for attorney's fees have been denied, it is clear that this motion is surrounded by much different circumstances. Since discovery is complete and the case is ready to proceed to trial, FWC should be entitled to reasonable compensation for past services and expenses, or at a minimum future pre-trail expense.

CONCLUSION

For all of the foregoing reasons Lynn Smith's motion to provide monthly living expenses and attorney fees should be granted.

Upon release from imprisonment, the defendant shall be on supervised release for a term of:

3 years on each of Counts 1,8 through 10, 14, 17, 21 through 26, and 1 year on each of Counts 30 through 32, terms to run concurrently.

The defendant must report to the probation office in the district to which the defendant is released within 72 hours of release from the custody of the Bureau of Prisons.

The defendant shall not commit another federal, state or local crime.

The defendant shall not unlawfully possess a controlled substance. The defendant shall refrain from any unlawful use of a controlled substance. The defendant shall submit to one drug test within 15 days of release from imprisonment and at least two periodic drug tests thereafter, as determined by the court.

- The above drug testing condition is suspended, based on the court's determination that the defendant poses a low risk of future substance abuse. (Check, if applicable.)
- X The defendant shall not possess a firearm, destructive device, or any other dangerous weapon.
- The defendant shall cooperate in the collection of DNA as directed by the probation officer. (Deselect, if inapplicable.) X

- The defendant shall participate in an approved program for domestic violence. (Check, if applicable.)

- the defendant shall refrain from excessive use of alcohol and shall not purchase, possess, use, distribute, import, or manufacture any and all controlled substance and all controlled substance analogues, as defined in 21 U.S.C. § 802, and any paraphernalia related to any controlled substances, except that possession and use of a controlled substance properly prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner is permitted:
- the defendant shall not frequent places where controlled substances are illegally sold, used, distributed, or administered;
